Discussion

The Academic Affairs Committee met twice to discuss the Academic Calendar.

The following questions/comments were forwarded to Dr. Nelson and the responses are provided.

- July 4 – still mark as holiday for session 2 (since it's in between last day of classes and final) -- could clarify that Univ is closed for that day (e.g., requests for extensions, plans to use the Library, etc.)

Corrected.

- Commencement dates - # of days in the columns don't seem to line up with the blue highlighted dates

The cell for May 15 is now part yellow and part blue.

The dates for the next commencement were decided very recently as May 15-17 (Friday-Sunday). The calendars for all years have been modified accordingly.

- Cells seem to be merged into one cell for years after 25-25 and appear under "Fall". Inconsistencies (centered in middle on some years and not on others)

Corrected.

- CIVIC & VOTER DATES: several not listed (early voting, last day to register, general election day) (requirements listed here: https://www.cpp.edu/senate/documents/packets/2022-23/08.10.22/scvea-academic-calendar-requirements_8.1.2022.pdf)

Dates are now present for 2025-26.

- White font on Jan 23 in 25-26 calendar does not appear to have particular significance?

On the visual calendar page? If so, that doesn't show on my current version.

- Final exams (see p.3) - in Fall they begin on Monday and go through Sunday; in Spring, they begin on Saturday and go through Thursday. Is this because of Commencement? Should we be consistent about this?

Final exams are Saturday through Friday in spring to eliminate finals on Saturday, which has large commencement ceremonies. The spring semester first workday for faculty is a Friday to compensate for the number of workdays.

- Dec 24th in 2028 is listed as when Christmas is observed (a Sunday), but Dec 25 for other years. If it's a Sunday, how is it a day when it's observed for the purposes of classes?

Thank you for finding this. There was a copying error for the winter holiday dates in that calendar which has been corrected.

- Several lines in the “Scheduling and Reg” columns of the calendars AY26 and above have words cut off—perhaps expand those rows a bit?

This has been adjusted in the current version.

- On the visual calendar, the years on sides of the calendar need to be updated (they’re still 24-25, not 25-26). Consistent/running typo on years

Corrected. Thank you!

- Can we show the dates for the retroactive withdrawal deadlines (15th day of classes in : https://www.cpp.edu/academic-manual/1400-1499-academic-standards-regulations/policy_1413-retroactive-withdrawal1.pdf

This item needs a separate discussion. The dates can certainly be added to the calendar. However, the dates currently posted on the office of student success website (<https://www.cpp.edu/studentsuccess/oss/academic-advising/university-policy-information/retroactive-withdrawal.shtml>) do not follow Policy 1413.

- Could we indicate the overlap of Friday classes/exams and commencement? 2024-2025 distinguishes this, but May 2026 (listed as May 2025 by mistake) doesn’t.

The colors have been adjusted in the 2025-26 Visual Calendar.

- PAGE 2: June 4th as start of academic year and summer session. Later than normal (just double checking; June 4th was the date in previous calendars for the start of the academic year).

This date depends on which day of the week January 1 falls on. Because of fitting all the sessions together, this date is the Wednesday closest to June 1. There is a discussion in progress of adjusting this date by a day or so, and I will need to get back to you if there is a change.

- July 9th 2025 (listed as 2024 on visual calendar) is in light blue – is this because it’s the only day that doesn’t overlap with another session?

Yes. It is the only day which is only in the 10 week summer session. Priority in color of the summer session days in the Visual Calendar page has historically been given to the two shorter sessions due to the challenges of making dual-colored cells in excel display the two colors appropriately. The 2-color excel format options are graded between the two colors, done numerically. Thus, most of the cell does not look like either color. Each cell has to be modified individually with an additional shape to show the two colors. (This page already takes much more time to create than the entire rest of the five-year pages. Even with assistance from someone more skilled at excel than I, and multiple people proofing it, it is the one with the most errors.)

- Starting page 2: spring instruction break references 04/01/2024; remove or update as appropriate.

Thank you! The text has been updated to say "campus open except for observance of Cesar Chavez Day" for all years.

- Spring Semester 2026 on Visual Calendar – Jan 17 listed as first day of classes (for Sat classes? Will they be held before MLK day and Jan 20?).

Yes. Otherwise they would have to be held on the Saturday of commencement weekend. Finals held during commencement pose all sorts of problems with parking and access to the campus, plus ensuring that they are held in areas which are far enough from the quad that the space is quiet.

- Commencement dates for 26-27 listed under Fall instead of Spring (same in 27-28 and 28-29)

Corrected.

- 28-29: End of semester and grades due dates don't line up as the same date (like other years)

Yes. This is deliberate. In that year, December 22 is the last day before Christmas is observed. The state gives half that day off and the President has traditionally provided the other half day, so this is very unlikely to be a work day for staff in the Registrar's office. Moving the grades-due date early one day has been done to avoid complications of having an important processing date on a day when the necessary staff won't be working.

- Winter 2-week sessions: Winter 2026 2-weeks session starts on the 29th of December but Dec 29-Jan 1 are marked as holidays in the visual calendar. This is a bit confusing.

Thanks for pointing this out. This year is a bit awkward for that session. I will change for classes to start on January 2.

- Winter 2027 2-week classes start in January. I wonder if this is how it is supposed to be.

Yes.

- 25-26 calendar, scheduling/registration, 7th item, Jan 31 should be Jan 1 (not Jan 31-13) or should it be Jan 31 – Feb 13? (Does it need to line up with the census date?)

The 7th item in Scheduling and Registration is New Student Orientation.

- Dec 25 – last day to drop / receive refund (on multiple years) - should we have a deadline like this when everything is closed?

The date has been changed.

- Red vertical lines on visual calendar during September and January – not listed in the legend, but seem intentional. What do these mean? (seems to be lasting from holidays from 23-24 calendar)

Corrected.

- Start date for Dec 29 second session – wrong date? Should 2-week session start on Jan 2nd? Or how should this be scheduled? We think this may be an error (this is an issue in AY 25-26 and 26-27)

Changed in both years.

- Retroactive withdrawal dates – we should add these to the calendar, right?

See discussion above.
