SUBJECT: Response to Senate Report AS-3190-256-AP: New State-Support Master of Science in
Computer Engineering

The Academic Senate recommends approval of the new state-supported MS in Computer Engineering, with implementation in Fall 2027. The MS in Computer Engineering emphasizes hardware-software integration, systems engineering, and engineering-focused research, with a separate course catalog, distinct PLOs, and a different student population, precluding any meaningful curricular overlap with the MS in Computer Science program.

I thank the Office of Academic Programs and the Academic Senate for their recommendation. I support Provost Gomez, the Academic Senate, and the Office of Academic Programs with the approval of the new state-support Master of Science in Computer Engineering, and request that this report be officially recorded.
