Background: Both policies 1206 and 1207 use the former title "AVP for Research and Graduate Studies". This position has been renamed the AVP for Research, Innovation, and Economic Development, and may be renamed again in the future. In order to make these policies robust to changes of name of this administrative position, a generic description of the position would be helpful. The suggested wording is "the Associate Vice President with responsibility for research activities".
