9.Background

Policy 1207 has undergone a limited update to align with recent revisions to the federal Public Health Service Policies on Research Misconduct (42 CFR Part 93) issued by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Office of Research Integrity. The amended federal regulations became applicable on January 1, 2026, and require institutions that receive Public Health Services research funding to ensure their research misconduct policies reflect updated regulatory expectations. The proposed

minimal revisions make targeted, technical changes to Policy 1207 to ensure continued federal compliance; they do not alter the University's existing standards, procedures, or shared governance roles related to the review of research misconduct allegations.
